Jolaseta Blanco, Bodegas Agronavarra, Spain Tasting Note: Delicate white, crisp and refreshing, with flavours of apple and pear and a splash of lemon on the finish

Les Granges de Félines Blanc, Domaine de Belle Mare, Languedoc, France Tasting Note: A fantastic representation of new-style Languedoc wines. A brilliant colour with a pale-yellow tint and green hues; fresh nose of white flowers and fruits; freshness in the mouth.

Pinot Grigio, Via Nova, Veneto, Italy Tasting Note: Easy-drinking, well-balanced, lemony Pinot Grigio, as refreshing as lemonade but more substantial.

Red

Melodias Malbec, Trapiche, Argentina, Mendoza Tasting Note: Argentinian Malbec, bursting with raspberries and red cherries beneath a lovely, lasting fragrance of violets.

Jolaseta Tempranillo, Bodegas Agronavarra, Spain, Navarra Tasting Note: Tangy Tempranillo, a bowlful of red fruits - red cherries, redcurrants - with a sensual hint of truffle on the nose.

Tooma River Shiraz, Tooma River, Australia, South Australia

Tasting Note: Classic South Australian Shiraz, a smooth blend of juicy dark fruit, a hint of chocolate and lively spice, including the familiar black pepper.

Rose

Jolaseta Rosado, Bodegas Agronavarra, Spain, Navarra Tasting Note: Bright, juicy Spanish rosé, gently spiced and packed with raspberries and strawberries.

White

Picpoul de Pinet, Réserve de la Roquemolière – Languedoc-Roussillon, France Tasting Note: Soft, floral white from southern France, dry and delicate, exuding acacia, hawthorn blossom and citronella.

Old Vine Reserve Chenin Blanc, Ken Forrester Wines – South Africa Tasting Note: Full bodied and well rounded with a complex structure. Bursting with flavours of dried apricots, pineapple and hints of vanilla and honey that last long on the finish.

Red

Cabernet Sauvignon, Vinamar – Chile, Casablanca Valley Tasting Note: Fresh, balanced Chilean Cabernet Sauvignon, delivering a mouthful of berries, a flavour of cherries and a perfume of vanilla.

Rioja Crianza, Ramón Bilbao – Spain, Rioja

Tasting Note: Rioja from a respected producer, full of black fruit plus an intriguing sour note, so that added to the sweetness of blackberries and blackcurrants comes the tang of blackberry yoghurt.

Rose

Pinot Grigio Blush, Il Sospiro Italy, Sicily Tasting Note: The definition of easy-drinking, this Sicilian Pinot Grigio blush exhales cranberry, citrus and red berries... which may be why its name translates as 'the sigh
